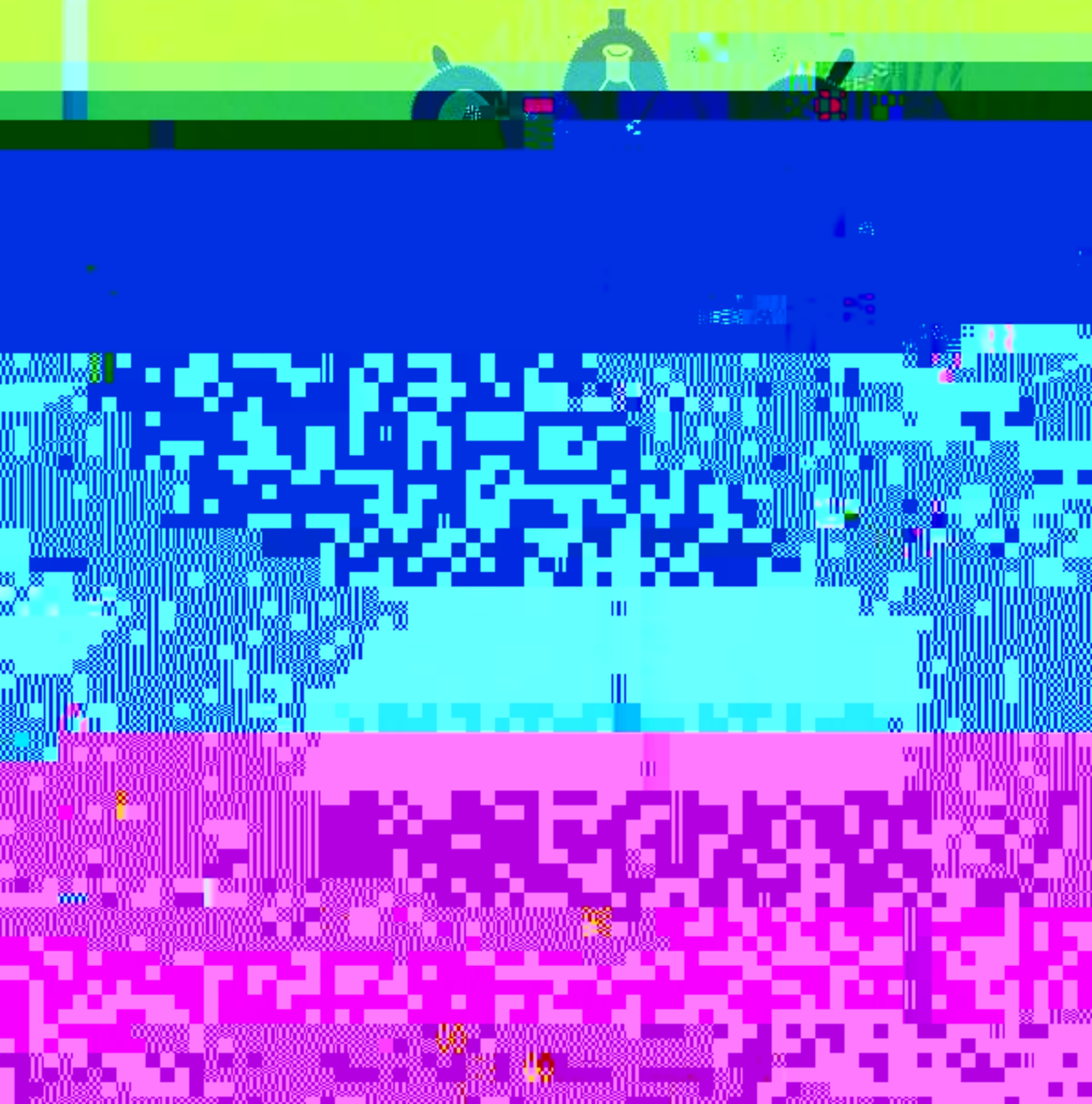

More than usual student body came to the UAF campus to participate in the 11th Alaska Rhetorics Institute (RAHI), smaller, but spirited and talented indeed.

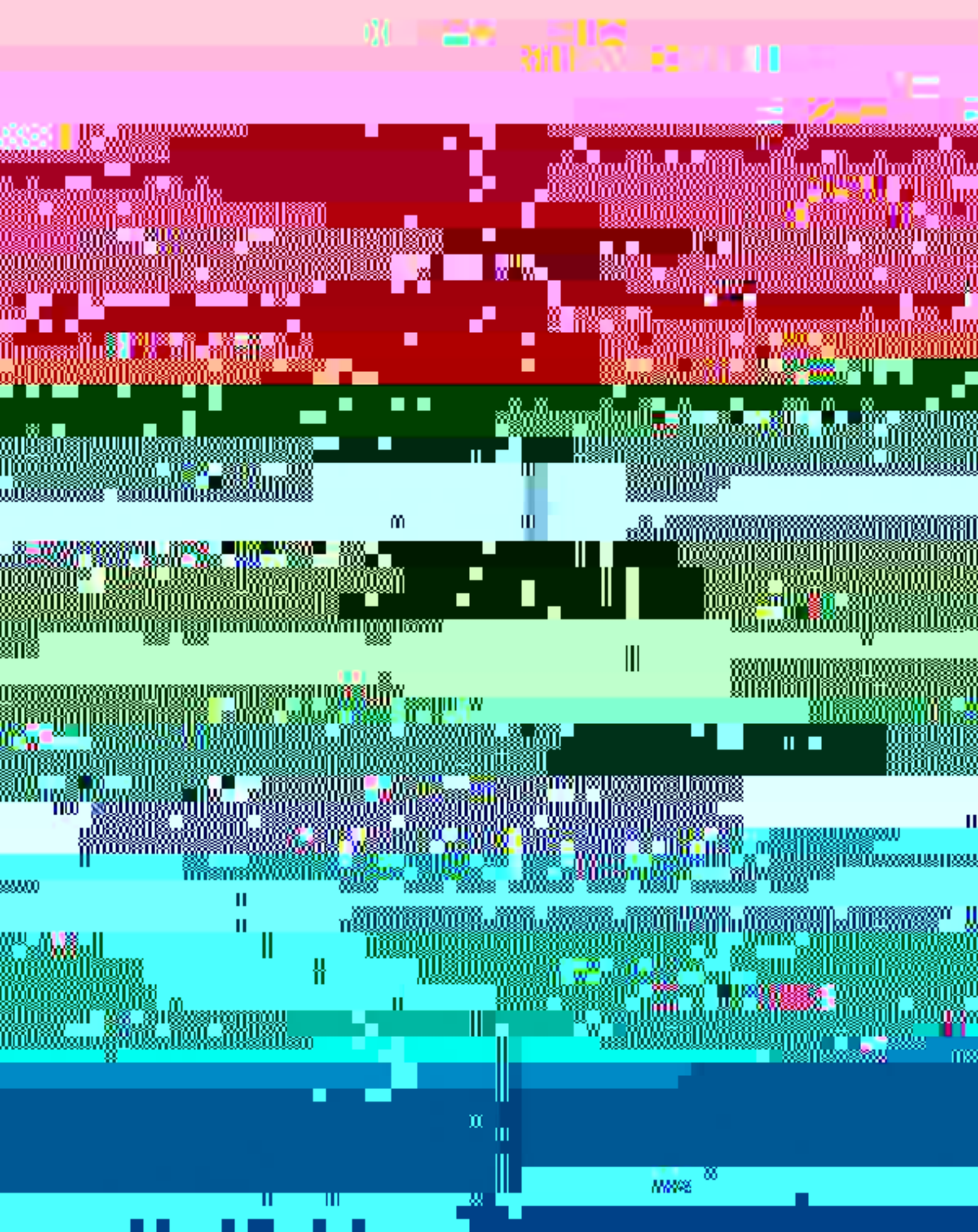
