- 4) **NOT ALLOW**
Dean/Director's Office should
Faculty Senate
 - Tenure-track, research, and other full-time Faculty Senate, and may participate in the process of their appointment.
 - Faculty with joint appointments should be appointed by the primary appointing authority, determined as follows:
 - Faculty with joint appointments with the Dean/Director's Office are represented by the Dean/Director's Office.
 - Faculty with joint appointments with the Dean/Director's Office and another unit should be appointed by the Dean/Director's Office.
 - In accordance with the Faculty Handbook (G.I. 1.1.1), the Dean/Director's Office should represent the Faculty in all matters relating to the Faculty's research, instruction, and service.
 - Faculty with joint appointments should be represented by the Dean/Director's Office.
