Be it further resolved, the Faculty Alliance urges the faculty of the AKNS Council to work with the GER Coordinating Task Force and the curriculum review process to propose a new requirement that will be implemented with the following principles in mind:

- the new requirement should be integrated with existing GER requirements and not add to the total number of GER credits required at each university;
- the requirement should have multiple options to complete this requirement;
- the requirement should be designed to avoid enrollment bottlenecks and to maximize the use of existing resources.
