Minimum publications

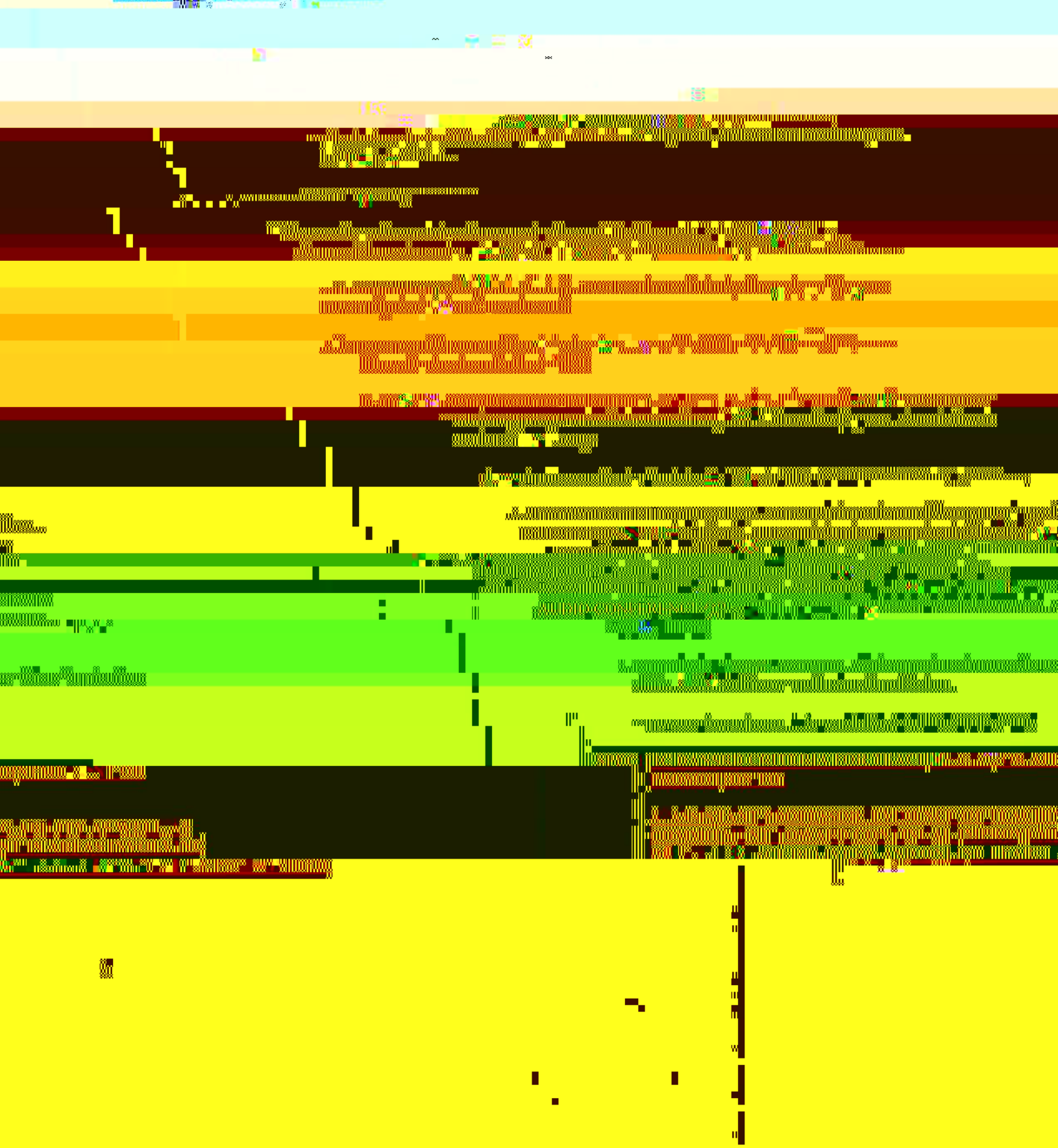
